

**Travel Information for Out-of-Town  
Ethical Worlds of Stem Cell Medicine

We are looking forward to your visit to the Bay Area! In order to help you prepare for your trip, we have compiled the following information.

**Travel Arrangements for Out-of-Town Visitors**

1. Make sure you retain all of your original travel receipts and boarding passes as the UC accounting office requires them for the purposes of reimbursement.
2. You will also be required to provide credit card statements to demonstrate payment of credit card purchases (all private irrelevant information should be blacked out).
3. If you are flying, your domestic airfare at economy class will be covered. The best option is to make your own reservations and submit your receipts and boarding passes for reimbursement. 4. The Bay Area has two local airports, Oakland (OAK) and San Francisco (SFO). Since the hotel accommodations are located in San Francisco, it is recommended that guests fly into SFO. Transportation to and from the airports are easy and reasonably priced using a shuttle service. We suggest Super Shuttle (reservations: <http://www.supershuttle.com>). Reservations are necessary if you fly into Oakland, but they are not necessary at SFO; you can pick up a ride at the airport. If your plane is so late that a shuttle is unavailable, we will reimburse you for a taxi ride.

**Lodging**

Reservations have been made for out-of-town guest at the Stanyan Park Hotel (<http://www.stanyanpark.com/>) in San Francisco. The Stanyan Park Hotel is located at Stanyan and Waller St and is conveniently located next to the UCSF Parnassus Campus. Clair Dunne will contact individual speakers to confirm your reservation.

Honoraria will be processed after the conference. For tax purposes, we will need your Social Security number to process this request.

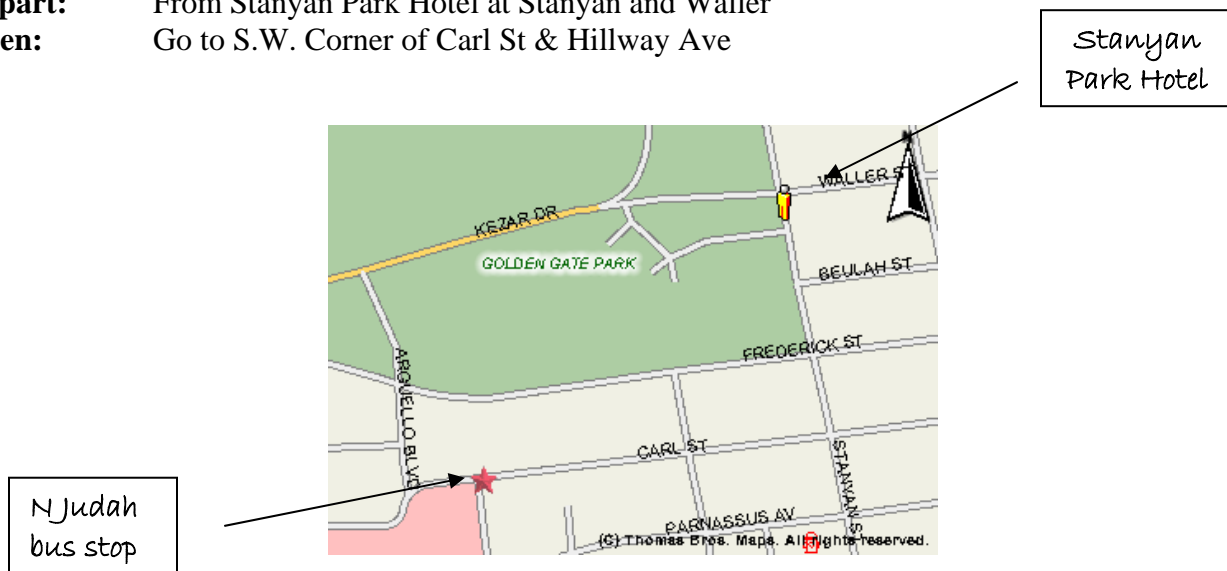
## Transportation to UC Berkeley on September 29<sup>th</sup>

To travel to Berkeley, you will take the N Judah line to the Embarcadero Center. You will then take Bart to the Downtown Berkeley Bart Station (see below for more details).

## To Arrive At UC Berkeley By 1:30pm:

**Depart:** From Stanyan Park Hotel at Stanyan and Waller

**Then:** Go to S.W. Corner of Carl St & Hillway Ave



**Board:** SF Muni - N Line/Judah at 12:36 pm (next train at 12:46 pm)

**Fare:** Pay \$1.50

**Get Off:** Metro Embarcadero Station at 12:55 pm

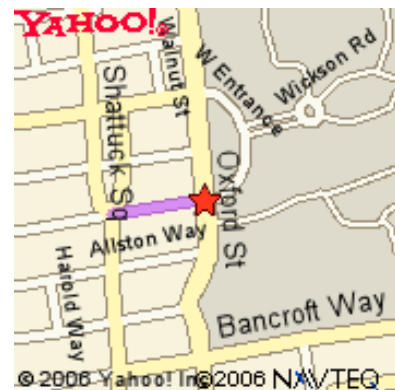
Take the escalators to the main transit area and look for the entrance to the Bart trains. Both Muni and Bart share the same station.

**Then:** Get BART Ticket - Pay \$3.25

**Board:** BART. Take the Richmond bound train at 1:06 pm (next train at 1:21 pm)

**Get Off:** BART Downtown Berkeley at 1:27 pm

**Go to:** Walk north to Center Street and then take Center street east for 1 block to the Berkeley campus.



## **September 28<sup>th</sup> - UC San Francisco**

Friday's Meeting will be held at the Millberry Union Conference Center, 500 Parnassus Avenue. Although the conference center is located a little less than a mile from the hotel, it is all uphill on the way to the Parnassus Campus.



### **Driving Directions to UCSF – Millberry Union Conference Center** 500 Parnassus Avenue

#### **From East Bay**

1. From I-80 after crossing the Bay Bridge, stay in the second lane from the right.
2. Exit to the RIGHT on "101 NORTH/GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE".
3. Get in the LEFT lane and Exit "OCTAVIA BLVD./FELL STREET."
4. Turn LEFT on FELL STREET.
5. Get in the far right lane and turn LEFT on STANYAN STREET.
6. Turn RIGHT on PARNASSUS AVENUE
7. Proceed for about 2 blocks, passing Hillway Ave on your right, and then turning right into the Parking Garage entrance.
